Record Load Updates

1. Resolved issue with date columns displaying 01/01/00 for blank dates.

Issue observed if system date set for 2-digit Year and date field contains a blank date. When records loaded into the SmartList it would show 01/01/00 instead of blank. This is now updated so it correctly shows a blank date.

Build 16.015 – Aug 25, 2020

Excel Export Updates

1. Resolved issue with additional columns having prevailing 0's stripped on export when grouping by column.

Issue observed should SmartList contain multiple columns with prevailing 0's and one of these columns was grouped the additional column with prevailing 0's had the 0's stripped on the excel export. This issue is now resolved.

Build 16.014 – July 24, 2020

Excel Export Updates

1. Resolved issue with ASL export to excel stripping prevailing 0's on grouped columns

Issue observed should column that is grouped contain prevailing 0's the prevailing 0's were stripped from the column. This issue is now resolved.

Build 16.013 – April 09, 2020

Resolved Issues

1. Resolved issue with Smartlist Designer Smartlist Objects.

Issue observed when user would change the column order for Smartlist Object that was built using SmartList Designer. When the columns changed the values were displayed in the incorrect order for these Columns.

Resolved Issues

Resolved issue with Filter Editor for Blanks and NonBlanks.
 Issue observed when using the Filter Editor on columns to display Blanks and NonBlanks not filtering results correctly. This is now resolved.

Enhancements

Improved performance when exporting with currency symbol.
 Code adjusted for exporting with currency symbol to improve the processing time when exporting to excel.



Resolved Issues

1. Resolved issue with Export to excel failing to display originating amounts for Smartlist objects created through Designer.

Issue observed when SmartList object is created through Designer and contains transactions that are not functional currency. The excel export is displaying the amount as 0.00 instead of the actual amount on the Originating currency. This issue is now resolved.

Build 16.010 - Jan 09, 2018

Resolved Issues

1. Resolved Latency issues when exporting to excel.

Issue observed when exporting to excel that export progress bar failed to update accordingly during export. This had also caused latency with the export to excel. This issue has been resolved which had also appeared to improve export performance.

Build 16.009 – Dec 13, 2017

Resolved Issues

- 1. Resolved issue with incorrect format with export with Currency Symbol. Issue observed when exporting to excel with currency symbol and the item has a number of decimal places for quantity greater than 0. If Quantity was less than 1000 then it exported to excel in the incorrect format. For example, if quantity was 132.0000 then it would show as 1 320 000 in excel instead of 132. This is now resolved.
- 2. Fixed problem with trailing blank space on String fields when exporting to Excel.

Problem was observed when exporting to Excel that String fields contained a blank space at the end of the string value. Users were unable to manually adjust in deleting the blank space in excel. This is now resolved.

3. Fixed Issues with Leading zeros on String fields being removed.
Issue observed that if String field contained leading zeros that the zeros were removed in the export to excel. This is now resolved.

Resolved Issues


1. Resolved decimal places export issue.

Issue observed when exporting to excel the decimal places was defaulting to 2 decimal places.


Updated added so that when exporting without currency symbol it will display the exact number of decimal places as shown in GP. However, it will no longer have a thousand separator. Should the decimal places in GP have a 0 value then it will display without decimal places in Excel as cell format will be general. For example, if



value in GP is \$1,000.000 then field will be display as 1000 in excel export when exporting without currency symbol.



Update Added when Exporting with Currency Symbol it will still display the 2-decimal place value in the exported report. However, the rounding of the fields will display the correct value for the full decimal places for the Line item. Should you require to display more decimal places you can highlight the entire column and adjust the format cells.

Resolved Issues

Resolved text fields converting to numeric when exporting to excel.
 Issue observed when exporting to excel should text field in SmartList object only contain a numeric value the export converted it to a numeric field setup. Any prevailing 0's were removed. This is now resolved.




Build 16.006 - June 06, 2017

Enhancements

1. New Record Count display when exporting records to excel.

When exporting to Excel you will now receive a record count indicating the number of rows remaining as part of the export. You have the option to stop the export by selecting the Stop button which will stop the export at the record remaining.



Resolved Issues

1. Resolved single quote on export to excel on string fields.

Previous export to Excel would resulted in a single quote at the beginning of each string field when exported to excel. This has been updated so the single quote is no longer used when exporting string fields.

Resolved Issues

1. Improved currency format issues in export to Excel.

Further issues observed for currency fields when export to excel with French Currency Format. Data exported as text when region language setting set for French Canadian Language. Problem has been resolved to ensure data is exported as data and cell format is correct based on excel export selection.

Enhancements

1. Improved Microsoft Office Interop Excel.

Microsoft Office Interop Excel DII updated to the latest available version 15.0.4569.1506 for improved compatibility with Office 2013 and higher.

Resolved Issues

1. Improved currency format issues in export to Excel.

Issue observed for currency fields when export to excel. Field exported as text when language setting set for French Canadian Language. Problem has been resolved to ensure data is exported as data and cell format is correct based on excel export selection.

Resolved Issues



1. Resolved issues with excel format for currency fields for French Canadian language settings.

Known issue that currency fields would export as text field types for amount fields with French Canadian Language settings. Issue has since been resolved. With Language setting as French Canadian amount fields will export in correct cell format.

Build 16.002 - Dec 20, 2016

Enhancements

1. Improve ASL export to Excel to default to normal layout when exported to excel.

With this update, users can still have Excel set for a Page layout or custom layout settings as the default layout but it will default as normal for the excel export.

Resolved Issues

1. Resolved issues with Currency format export to display in the proper format for French Canadian language settings.

Issue was observed which resulted in Currency fields displaying in incorrect format when exported to excel for French Canadian language settings. This update provided will display the currency as proper format but as a text field.

2. Resolved problems with Currency Symbol still displaying when exporting without currency symbol.

Issue was observed when currency field was Originating amounts. When exporting without currency symbol the originating amount fields would still display the currency symbol. This issue has since been resolved.

2. ASL build created for GP2016

Code was rolled up from ASL Build 6 of GP2015.
